## TIMOTHY F. JOHNSON, Ph.D. Biography

Raised as an only child by his single mother, the Founder and National President/CEO of the Frederick Douglass Foundation, Dr. Timothy F. Johnson made national history on June 13, 2009, when he was elected Vice Chairman of the North Carolina Republican Party, becoming the first Black American to hold the position and the highest ranking party official since the state party's inception, March 27, 1867.

Prior to that, in 2008, he made history when he became the first Black in western North Carolina to be elected Party Chairman by either of the two major political parties. Later that summer, he was elected to be a delegate to the 2008 Republican National Convention in Minneapolis and re-elected in the spring of 2009 as Chairman of the Buncombe County Republican Party

Born and raised in Cleveland, Ohio, Timothy earned the Boy Scouts of America's highest rank, the Eagle Scout Award, at the age of 14, a member of his High School's 1980 and 1981 state football championship teams, pledged Kappa Alpha Psi, Fraternity, Inc. as an freshman student while attending Miami University, initiated into the masonic order, consistory and Shriner club while serving simultaneously in the United States Army,, to name a few organizational affiliations.

Graduating 'Honor Graduate' from the United States Army Ammunition Advance Individual Training School, Dr. Johnson was later commissioned as a Second Lieutenant through the University of Arizona Wildcat Battalion. Serving a combine 23 years, he attained the rank of Major and received numerous military honors.

He is also the State Chairman of the Georgia Jail Diversion and Trauma Recovery for Veterans Advisory Council, President/CEO of Leadership 101 Training and Consulting Services, LLC and served previously as an Associate Professor of Military Science at Howard University, Washington, DC, and an adjunct instructor at Bryant-Stratton Business College, Beachwood, Ohio and Shaw University, Raleigh University. He holds degrees from the University of Arizona, Troy University and LaSalle University, respectively

Timothy is the proud father of four grown children and six grandchildren. He resides in Atlanta, GA
